What Is The Sports Premium?

The Government is providing funding of £150 million per annum for academic years 2014 /15 and 2015 /16 to provide new, substantial primary school sports funding. This funding is being jointly provided by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture and Media and Sport. We will see money going directly to primary schools to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for all children. The Sports Premium funding can only be spent on sport and PE provision in schools.

Purpose of the Funding

Schools will be required to spend the Sports Premium funding on improving the provision of PE and sport, but they will have freedom to choose how to do this.

How we will spend the Sports Premium funding and who will benefit

The Governors have agreed that the money will be used so that : all children benefit regardless of sporting ability; the most able children are given the opportunity to compete in tournaments; staff have access to training opportunities and continued professional development; swimming is subsidised in order to support all families financially.
