Online safety – Advice and guidance

Online safety is an important part of keeping children safe at our school and we recently highlighted this during Safer Internet Day. Our curriculum empowers children to understand and be aware of how they can stay safe and behave appropriately online, but we can only be successful in keeping children safe online if we work with you.
