Snacks and Drinks

We now have the regular fresh fruit delivery for our children in Herons and Wrens – this was slightly delayed at the start of term but is now in full operation. The children in these classes are all offered a piece of fruit at morning break time, therefore they do not need to bring in snacks from home. Can we please ask that you do not send them in with break time snacks – thank you.

For children in Martins and Peacocks, as we are not currently running our school tuck shop and the fruit for children scheme does not extend to Key Stage 2, they may bring in a **healthy snack** from home to be eaten at morning break. *No crisps or sweets please.*

Every child should bring in their own **named** water bottle every day – **this should only contain water please.**

Traffic and Parking

Thank you to everyone who is parking at Taylors Hill in the mornings and afternoons – this will really make a difference to the volume of traffic in the village. The red and white barriers that the council put in outside the school have created a safe place for parents and children to wait when arriving at school and until the gates open – please do use this space. They have, however, made it more difficult for cars to pass on School Hill – even more reasons to park at Taylors Hill car park and walk up!
