Dear Parents and Carers

To bring to life our summer term topic of Ancient Greece, we would like to take Peacocks to the British Museum in London. Their Ancient Greek galleries are full of incredible artefacts that the children can learn so much from.

We have planned the trip for Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> May and we will be travelling to London St Pancras from Chilham station, leaving on the 9:10am train. **Can you please make sure that your child is at Chilham station by 8:50am for registration.** Once at St Pancras, we will transfer to the London Underground (Piccadilly Line) for one stop, getting off at Russell Square, from there we can walk to the British Museum.

- Your child will need to wear their school uniform and a suitable coat and footwear, depending on the weather.
- They will need a packed lunch and a drink – no glass bottles or fizzy drinks, preferably in a small rucksack as they will be carrying their own bags all day.
- They will have the opportunity to visit the museum gift shop, so a maximum of £5.00 is more than sufficient for this in a named envelope, purse or wallet.

We will be getting the 3:07pm train from London, to arrive back at Chilham station at 4:02pm where you will be able to collect your child.

We are asking for a contribution of £12.12 per child to cover the cost of the travel to and from London. The museum itself is free.

The trip consent and payment need to be completed on ParentMail via the app. **When you go into the app, please click on 'Forms' first to complete the consent, and then 'Payments'. You may find that the item is added to your basket automatically so if you get a message to say 'purchase error more than 1 item', please just click on Basket at the bottom of the page and then you can go to the payment screen.**

**Please note the deadline is Friday, 12<sup>th</sup> May.** If you have difficulty paying for this trip, please contact Mrs Cooper or Mrs Woodland.

This really is an exciting opportunity to visit one of the London museums and it really will enhance our History topic for the summer term. Please don't hesitate to contact me should you have any questions regarding the trip.
