

Term 1 Key Information

Dear Parents and Carers

I do hope you have all had a wonderful summer break, with time to rest and recharge. We are all very much looking forward to welcoming the children back for the start of the new academic year.

Here is some key information and general reminders for the start of term:

- The first day of term for all children in Years 1-6 will be Monday 5th September 2022
- Children joining us in Year R (Wrens) will start back on Wednesday 7th September as per previous letters we have sent out to you
- The school gate will open at 8:35am each morning, where children should be dropped off to go straight to their classrooms. **The gate will close promptly at 8:55am**, so please ensure your child arrives in good time
- Morning club will commence on Monday 5th September and will be available every day from 8:00am - this must be booked in advance via Parentmail. **Please note that morning club will now be held in the main school building, so please come to the school office front door and ring the bell – Mrs Talbot will meet the children there**
- After school 4:30 club will commence on Monday 5th September and will be available every day throughout term time – this should also be booked in advance via Parentmail
- The gates will open at the end of the day at 3:10pm and parents should continue to use the same system as last academic year for collecting their children. We politely request that you do not linger too long on the playground once you have collected your child – thank you.
- Children in Wrens and Herons do not need to bring in a mid-morning snack as fruit is provided. Children in Martins and Peacocks can bring in a healthy snack if they wish – no sweets, chocolate or crisps please – and absolutely nothing containing nuts – thank you
- School tuck shop is available to children in Martins and Peacocks where they can purchase a snack for 20p
- All children should have their own named water bottle (water only please) in school every day
- **Please ensure all items of school uniform are clearly named – we will no longer be storing lost property in school. Instead, we will put out any lost property items every Friday for you to claim at the end of the day**

I will be sending out a more detailed newsletter at the end of the first week back, containing a list of key dates for the year ahead. Class welcome letters and curriculum maps will also be sent out at the beginning of next week.

We are really looking forward to seeing you all again and welcoming your children back to school for the new term.
